The applicant, or their contractor shall secure the plumbing permit, provide all necessary equipment, materials, and labor to make the connection, and notify New Jersey One Call for mark-outs.

When working with in a street Right-Of-Way, it is necessary for the applicant to apply for a Road Opening Permit from the Township Clerk or County Road Department, as applicable.

Applicant shall attach sketch of an adequate scale indicating the tie-in location related to the property and building. Block Number, Lot Number and Street name to be shown.

Applicant to provide opening for tap by the M.T.U.D. Applicant to check with M.T.U.D. to schedule tap. Applicant is responsible for wet tap charges as per the current rate schedule. Applicant shall provide all necessary permits, equipment, materials, labor, and notify New Jersey One Call for mark-outs.
